Senior Arts	 Rehearsal space and schedule has been established with the arts teachers The school remains dedicated to supporting the arts. All initiatives coming from staff and/or council committees, in this case specific to the arts but in all areas, MUST be approved by the principal to ensure all policies and procedures are adhered to 		
Student Voice	 Student Parliament and Girls' Government (Ward 7) is in place Administration and staff will continue to offer a variety of ways for students to share the voice (include but not limited to extracurriculars, though senior Guidance, via homeroom teachers and coaches and multiple leadership opportunities in class and school) 		
Communication	 Weekly communications from administration Reminders to all staff about consistent messaging and communication The model in the office, as in many large elementary schools, is that VPs are given portfolios by division. At Runnymede, VP Rovas is K-4 and VP George is grades 5-8. This structure is to support efficient response. Principal Zamin is consulted and aware of concerns and VPs escalate to her as needed. Much like the Parent Concern Protocol, it is best to go to the individual closest to the concern. 		
Budget	 Principal shared budget in November 2023 to SAC as per expected procedure New process for TRF introduced last year for improved communication regarding spending donations Budget is up to the discretion of the Principal and at Runnymede, all budget decision are done by committee 		
Supervision	 Principal is responsible for safe entry and exit Dismissal ends at 3:15 pm with supervision until 3:30 pm After 3:30 pm, the yard and playscape are available to community and supervision is the responsibility of the family We have a daycare partner on site as well as permit holders that may have access to the playscape and field. In those circumstances we ask that the larger community be respectful of those priorities.
